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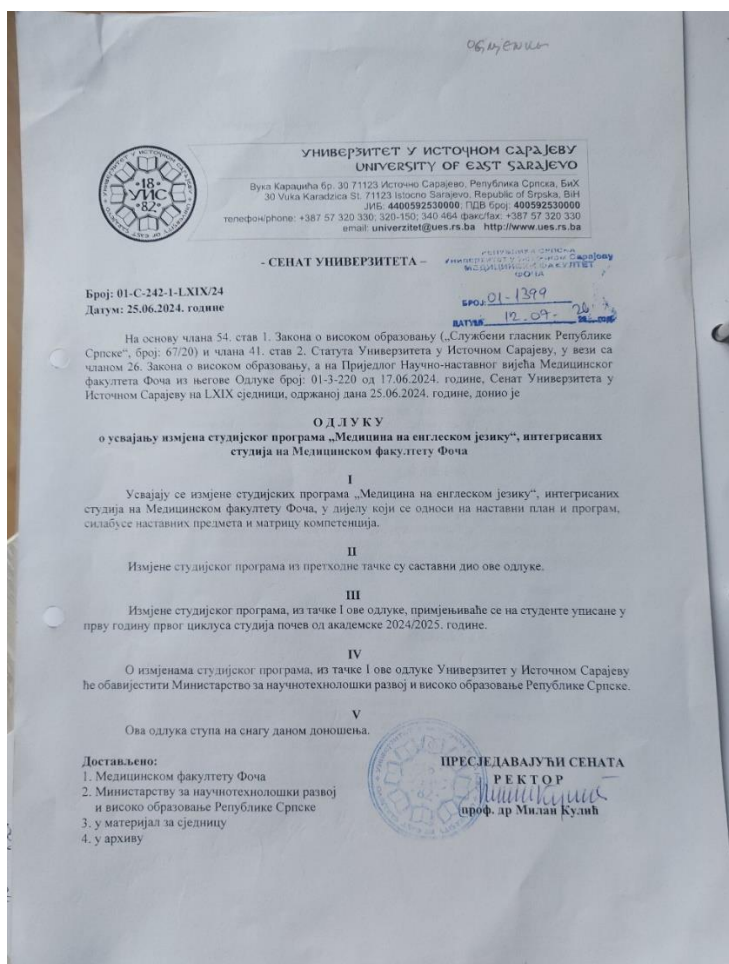
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The Faculty of Medicine of the University of East Sarajevo implemented internationalization in all subjects of all 6 years of study in June 2024 in accordance with the decision of the Faculty Council, which is an integral part of this report. All teachers and associates of the study program Medicine in English participated in this activity.

The key aspects of the internationalization of the curriculum were the English language, internationalized student learning outcomes, internationalized content, internationalized teaching and learning activities and internationalized assessment methods.

The main reason for the internationalization of subjects is the education of a large number of foreign students (about 500) who study in this study program.
